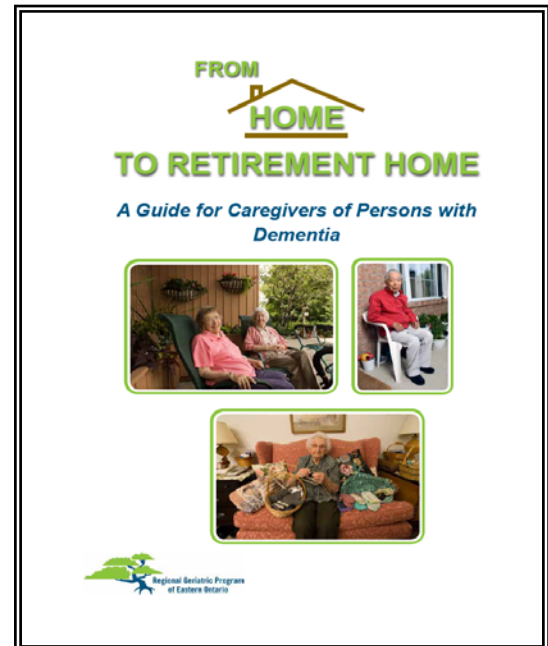


FROM HOME TO RETIREMENT HOME *A Guide for Caregivers of Persons with Dementia*

The Regional Geriatric Program of Eastern Ontario (RGPEO) has developed a guide for the caregivers of persons with dementia who are considering a move to a retirement home (or a retirement residence). Although mostly written for caregivers (family, friends or other unpaid helpers of persons with dementia), the guide is a useful resource for professional service providers as well. Portions may also be useful to persons in early stages of dementia who wish to be active participants in the process.

- ✓ What emotions to expect and how to cope
- ✓ How to plan to choose the right place
